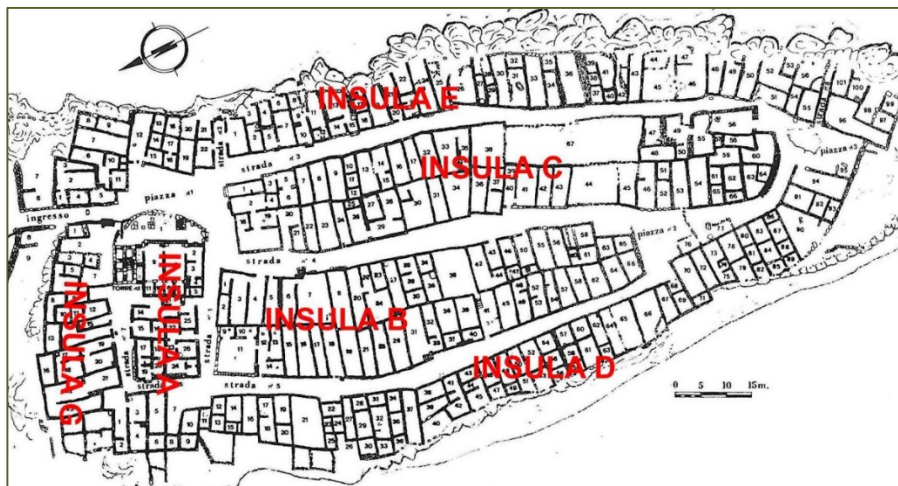

■ Insula 'B'

Of the various groups of blocks in Monte Sirai, *insula* B is distinguished by its central position. It is positioned south-west of '*insula* 'A', containing the temple of Astarte and craftsmen's buildings, and enclosed by the so-called 'Piazza no. 2', that encloses the space that is progressively narrowed between *insulae* 'C' and 'D'.

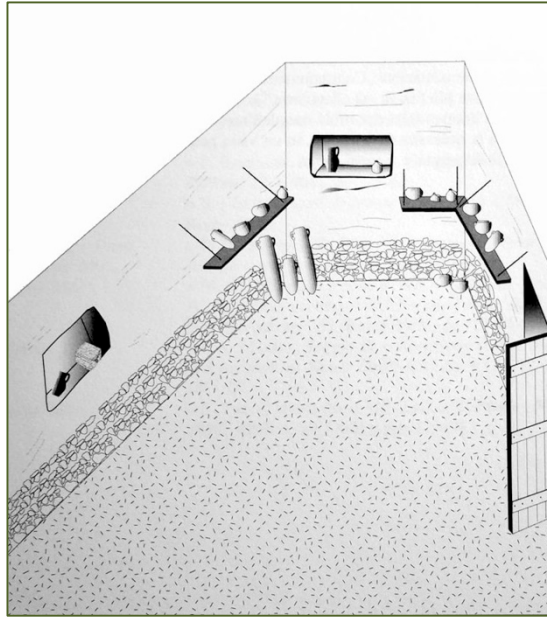


Fig. 3 - Reconstruction hypothesis of room B2. CAMPANELLA, FINOCCHI 2002, fig. 3.

The building complex, the smaller of the two blocks (D, E) along the edge of the high plain and the parallel *insula* 'C', further East, has one of the most important, well-known buildings in the acropolis, the 'casa Fantar', and nearby, other areas that were thoroughly investigated with their stratigraphy interpreted, with data that allowed the reconstruction of each room by space and findings (fig. 3).
